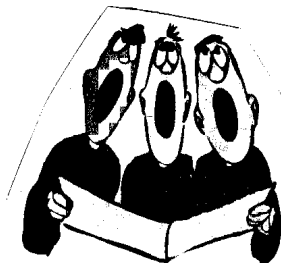

INTERNAL WORKS TO THE CHURCH : PLEASE PRAY!

For the benefit of newcomers, Spring 2010 will see the interior of St. Peter's transformed with a completely re-wired and re-decorated church, new lighting system and exciting new audio visual system involving the use of a range of screens and projection units. Full details of the works will be available for all to view shortly. The plans for the new Kitchen and works to the Hall have also been completed. A grant for £10,000 was confirmed from Chertsey Combined Charities with an application for a further £47,000 currently in the pipeline and awaiting final approval from another local funding organisation.
